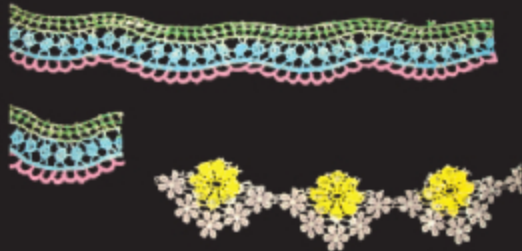


deColoured Lace Jeans

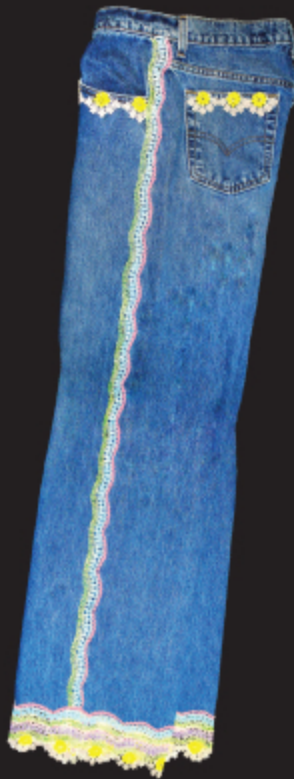
Using **deColourant**[®]
Dyeing Lace Without the Mess!

Instructions :

1. Select 100% cotton or rayon lace
2. Wash and dry lace
3. Press the lace so it lays flat
4. Cut to the approximate lengths needed. Make each piece a little longer than necessary in case the lace shrinks when washing after decolouring
5. Apply deColourant[®] to lace, "painting" lace as desired
6. Follow the manufacturer's directions for deColourant
7. Press. Wash. Press again
8. Sew decoloured lace onto the jeans by machine or hand using thread matching the decoloured portion of the lace

- Jeans
Lace

- Carnation Pink
 - Dusty Rose
 - Neon Pink
 - Pastel Mint Green
 - Robins Egg Blue
 - Sunlit Yellow
 - Warm Gray Violet
